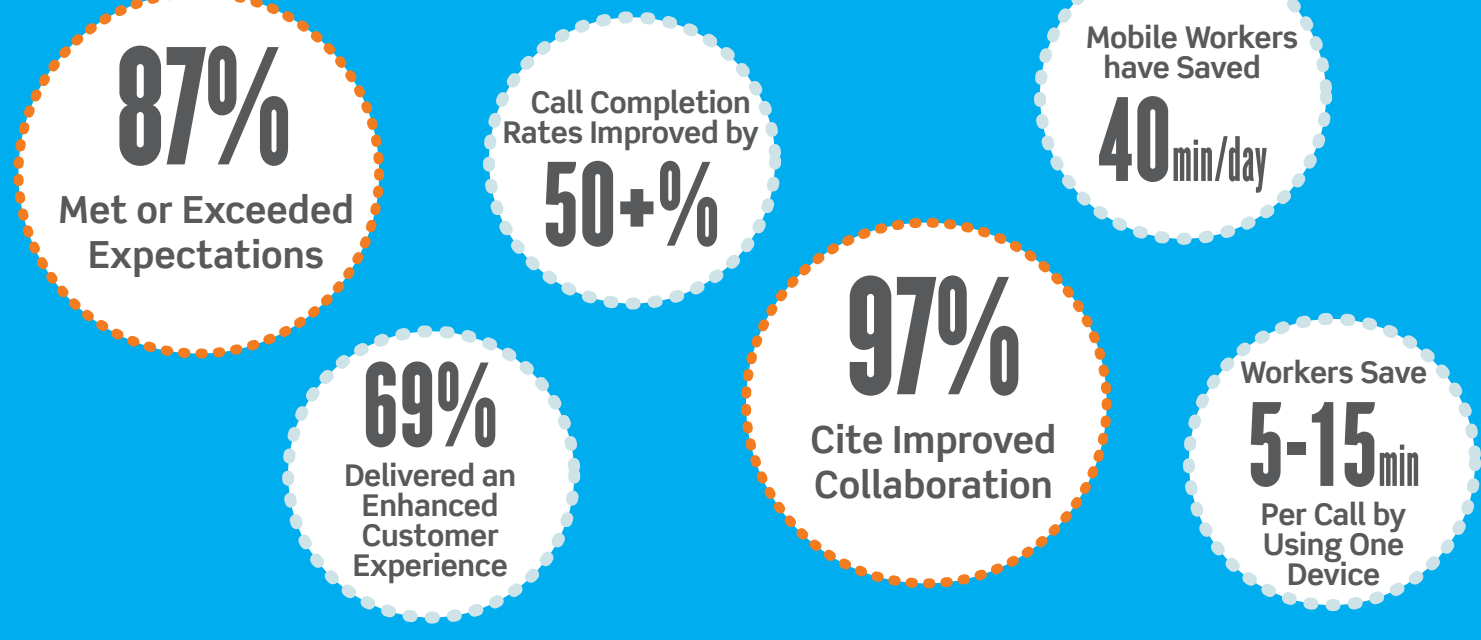

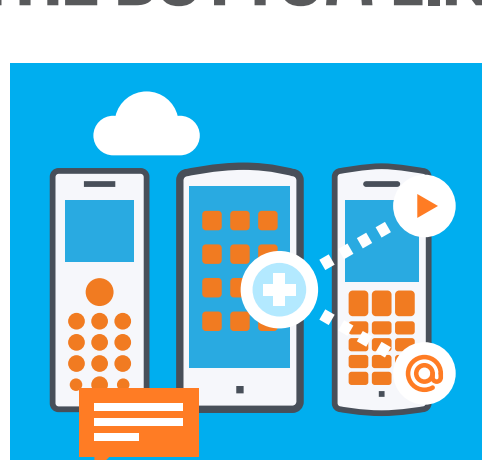

BENEFITS OF MOBILITY TO THE BOTTOM LINE

MOBILE UC

DRIVES WORKFLOW IMPROVEMENTS AND COST SAVINGS:



1 Transforming processes, organizations can save money and increase revenue.

10 hours per month per worker in productivity gains

In an organization with 1,000 employees the annual savings is:

$$10 \times \$30 \times 12 \times 1,000 = \$3.6 \text{ million}$$

$$10 \times \text{€}29.5 \times 12 \times 1,000 = \text{€}3.5 \text{ million}$$

2 Presence-enabled communications minimized the time spent locating others by 30 minutes per employee, per day.

For 1,000 employees, this translates into potential yearly cost savings of:

$$.5 \text{ hr} \times 245 \text{ working days} \times \$30 \times 1,000 = \$3.6 \text{ million}$$

$$.5 \text{ hr} \times 245 \text{ working days} \times \text{€}29.5 \times 1,000 = \text{€}3.6 \text{ million}$$

Both examples above are based on information and an average US Hourly Wage of \$30³ and an EMEA average Hourly Wage of €29.5¹⁴.
